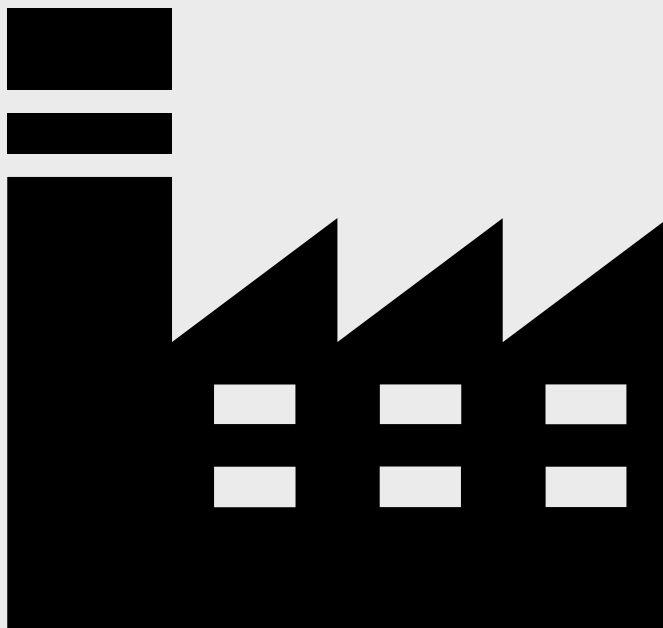


PLASTIC PALLETS SAVE YOU SPACE

It also means you have to order more often as you can't hold as much stock, again this costs you money. Because a lot of plastic pallets are stackable, they actually slot into each other, then you can store four times as many plastic pallets as wooden pallets.

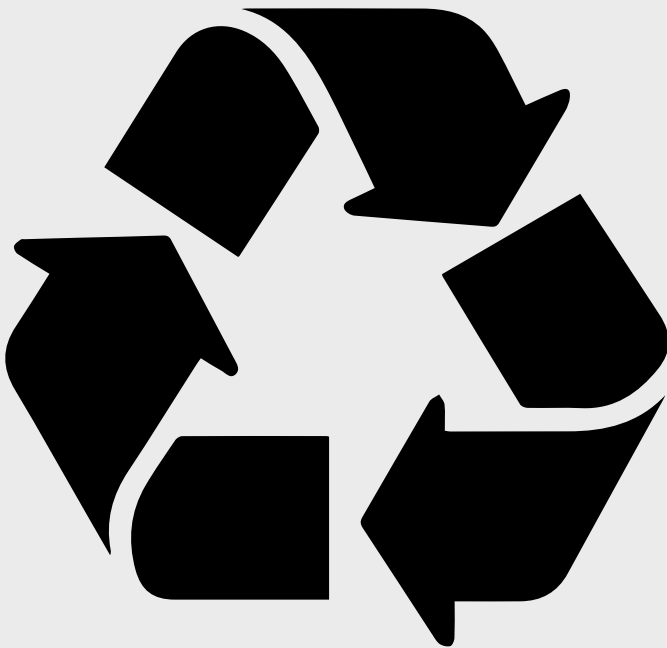
HELP YOU MEET YOUR RECYCLING TARGETS

No PPE needed to handle plastic pallets so they save money in that respect too.



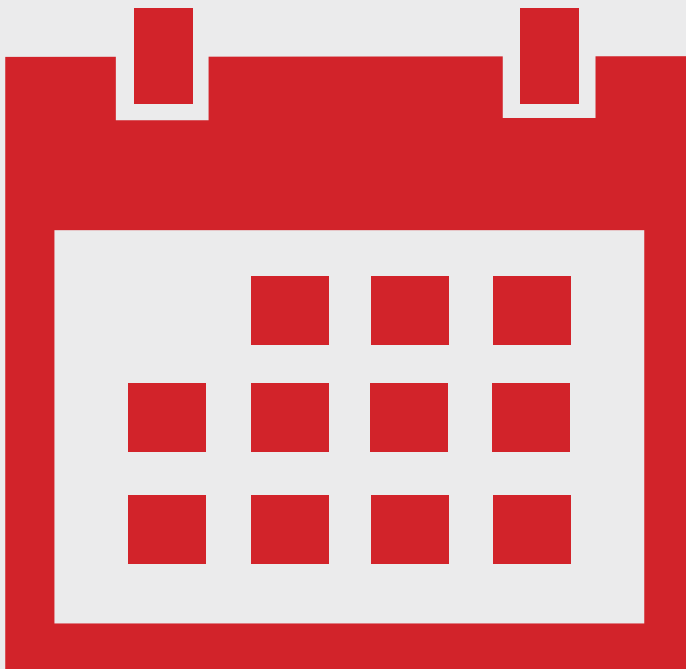

Depending on the pallet you need, plastic pallets can last up to 10 times longer than wooden pallets when used in a closed loop system.



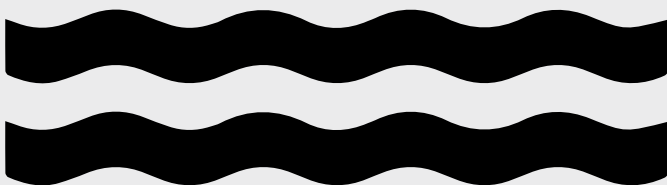
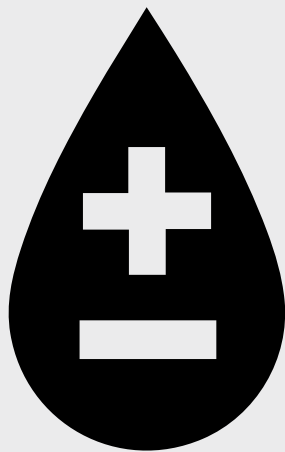

No brushing up after plastic pallets unlike wooden their wooden counterparts. With no splinters or rust, these pallets are the cleaner and smarter choice.

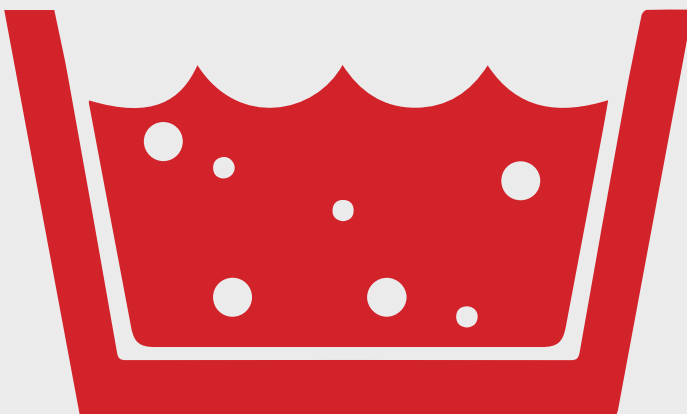


PLASTIC PALLETS ARE HYGIENIC

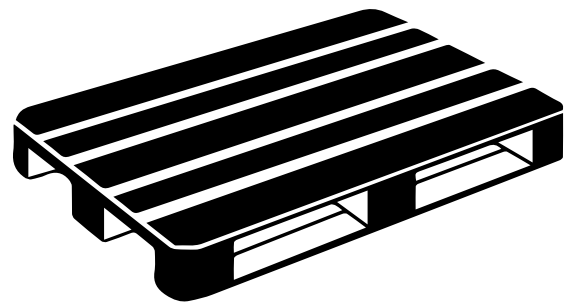
